

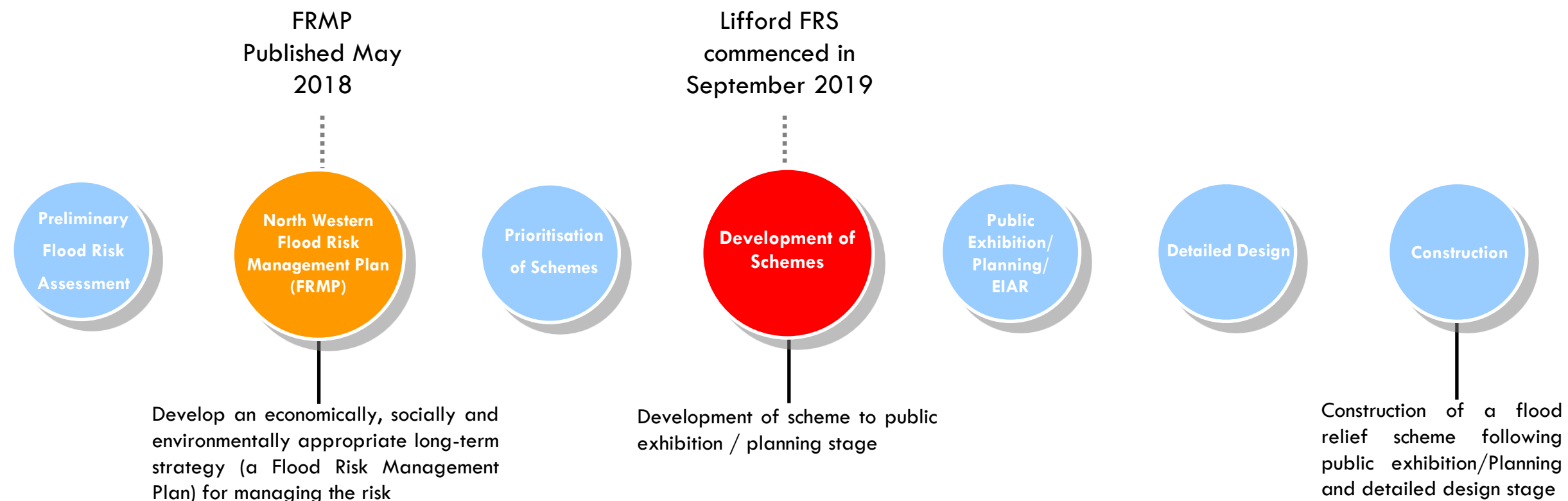
Lifford Flood Relief Scheme

Scheme Objectives & Overview

The Office of Public Works (OPW) have carried out a Flood Risk Management Plan (FRMP) for the North Western Region. This Plan set out a range of potential flood risk management options for particular areas within the catchment including Lifford.

The OPW has now commissioned Engineering and Environmental Studies to assess and develop a viable, cost-effective and sustainable Flood Relief Scheme for Lifford. A report will be prepared describing the findings of the Engineering Study, which will include a description of the measures proposed, scheme options assessed and the justification for the proposed scheme.

The Project Team includes a Design Team made up of consulting engineers, the OPW, and Donegal County Council in addition to the Environmental Team. A study area has been identified and the initial stages of the Lifford Flood Relief Scheme have commenced, including Constraints Study and Preliminary Design Surveys. An Indicative Flow chart showing the process from inception through to construction for a flood relief scheme is shown on the figure below:
